  - LBB audit results



#### The Use of our Classrooms has improved

- •Historical Rankings Average Weekly Hours
  - 8<sup>th</sup> in the State (2007 & 2008)
  - Failed to Meet the THECB Utilization Guideline
- Current Rankings Space Utilization Efficiency (SUE)
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> in the State (2008 & 2009)
  - Meet & Exceed the THECB Utilization Rule






# **Complex Campus Environment**

•Bike/Walk 2.8 miles






# **Management & Planning Efforts**
